#### **CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR STAFF, PARENTS AND STUDENTS AS 100% OF A LEVEL STUDENTS SECURE GRADES FOR ENTRY INTO DEGREE OPTIONS**

We are, once again, delighted that we have built on last year's success which saw some outstanding achievements by our students. KS5 Results, this August are clear reflection of on-going collaboration between the students, parents and staff at Guru Nanak Sikh Academy. All students who applied to university gained offers, including many securing places on extremely competitive courses at elite institutions with destinations spanning from Cambridge to Bristol and Southampton to Imperial College London.

Our assessment of the estimated grades provided by the exam boards is that we can expect these results to improve even further based on the government's 'triple lock' commitment.

Despite these strange times, we must acknowledge the hard work and commitment of the students and staff at Guru Nanak Sikh Academy. We are particularly pleased with the outcomes in Maths where nearly 50% of students achieved A\* or A (National average 2019 was 41%). 100% students in Further Maths achieved A\*. 76% of the all grades were Grade C or better. 99% of students achieved pass grades.
